APPLICATION FOR JOHN R. NEGER SCHOLARSHIP *(Established in 1992)*

AIM

To be awarded to individuals in the field of public purchasing to provide continuing education opportunities.

CRITERIA

To be eligible for the scholarship, an applicant must meet the following criteria:

1. Applicant must be a member of MACPP in good standing for a minimum of one year.
2. Applicant must attend a minimum of two events during the year prior to submission of application. Documentation of the two events must accompany the application form.
3. Applicant must submit a written application to the MACPP Professional Development Director prior to commencement of the educational event or examination. Application shall detail why the scholarship is being requested and how it will be used, including the following: (1) date of educational event or examination, (2) location, (3) name and description of event, (4) event fee, and (5) supervisor approval.
4. Scholarships are limited to one per year per applicant.
5. The applicant must submit an article to the MACPP newsletter following the activity.

PROCESS

Upon receipt of the completed application by the MACPP Professional Development Director, the MACPP Executive Board will, in turn, review the application to determine if all criteria have been met and if funds are available. Scholarships will be awarded based on available funding. Award of the scholarship requires a majority vote of the MACPP Executive Board. If a member of the Executive Board applies, they will abstain from voting.

The scholarship must be used for educational purposes such as NIGP seminars, MACPP sponsored seminars, college level courses related to public purchasing, or expenses associated with CPPB or CPPO certification or recertification. The applicant is responsible for completing and submitting their own application to the sponsor of the educational event. Checks will be made out to the scholarship recipient.

APPLICANT PROCEDURE

1. Complete the application form.
2. Submit completed application to the current Professional Development Director preferably via e-mail (US Mail is acceptable using the PO Box shown on this form).
